Children First

On 11 December 2017 the remaining provisions of the Children First Act commenced in full. Most notably for the Camogie Association our immediate requirements include adopting all provisions in relation to mandatory reporting of child abuse, ensuring the appointment of what can be termed key child safeguarding officers which include Designated Liaison Persons and Children's Officers at Club and County level and also appointing the Association's Mandated Person, we must also provide certain child safeguarding training programmes and commence the process to agree a Child Safeguarding Statement for all Clubs.
