### **TARGET AUDIENCE:**

Available to all clubs.



#### **OBJECTIVE:**

Increase the availability of skilled and qualified referees within counties and support them on their developmental journey



#### **TARGET NUMBERS:**

Courses are open to participants from all counties and units with courses running in person with a maximum of 30 per in-person course. A number of these courses will be available online and advertised from February.



**SUITABLE FOR:** Courses are open to participants from all counties.

- First Whistle Course: Participants must be at least 15 years of age to partake
- Refresher Course: Participants must be at least 18 years of age
- Foundation Course: Participants must be at least 18 years of age
- Conversion Course: Participants must be at least 18 years of age
- Workshops/CPD's: Participants must be at least 18 years of age, unless otherwise stated

#### **TARGET AUDIENCE:**

Female Club Referees aged 18 and over



**OBJECTIVE:** Increase the availability of skilled and qualified female referees within counties and support them on their developmental journey through an academy programme of mentoring, experience, education, and training.



#### **TARGET NUMBERS:**

54 female referees per year over a 2-year period



**SUITABLE FOR:** New female referees at club level or those in their first three years of refereeing, all of whom are at least 18 years of age
