Sanction Insurance Requirements

- Camogie Players who are travelling internationally for the summer **MUST** be registered club members in order to receive a sanction to allow them play on a temporary basis with clubs in these areas.
- It is mandatory that all players obtain appropriate insurance cover before a permit to an international country can be granted.

- The GAA has a scheme in place which provides adequate cover of which the Camogie can avail.
- ***(Note persons who take out other insurance such as J1 Visa travel cover providers, need to ensure that cover is provided for injuries sustained whilst playing Camogie. This is not an automatic cover on most travel covers and the persons will need to declare they will be playing Camogie as part of a team and may have to pay an additional premium. They must provide details of their Insurance to The Camogie Association with their sanction before approval can be granted).***
